Call 999 in an emergency.

What is an emergency?

- When someone's life is in danger
- Someone might be or has been injured
- A crime is happening or is about to happen



101

To report something that is **NOT** an emergency, you can call **101** and speak to a call taker. You may have to wait a while to speak to someone.

Remember you can also '**Do it online**'.



If you are hard of hearing or have a speech impairment you can use the **Emergency** only SMS text service: **80999**. Text 'register' to **80999** or register online at www.emergencysms.org.uk

Textphone emergency: **18000**

Textphone non-emergency: **18001 101**

On our **website** you can:

- make general enquiries
- report crime or incidents that are not an emergency
- ask for an officer to call you back
- leave a message for an officer.

This may be quicker and easier than calling **101**.
